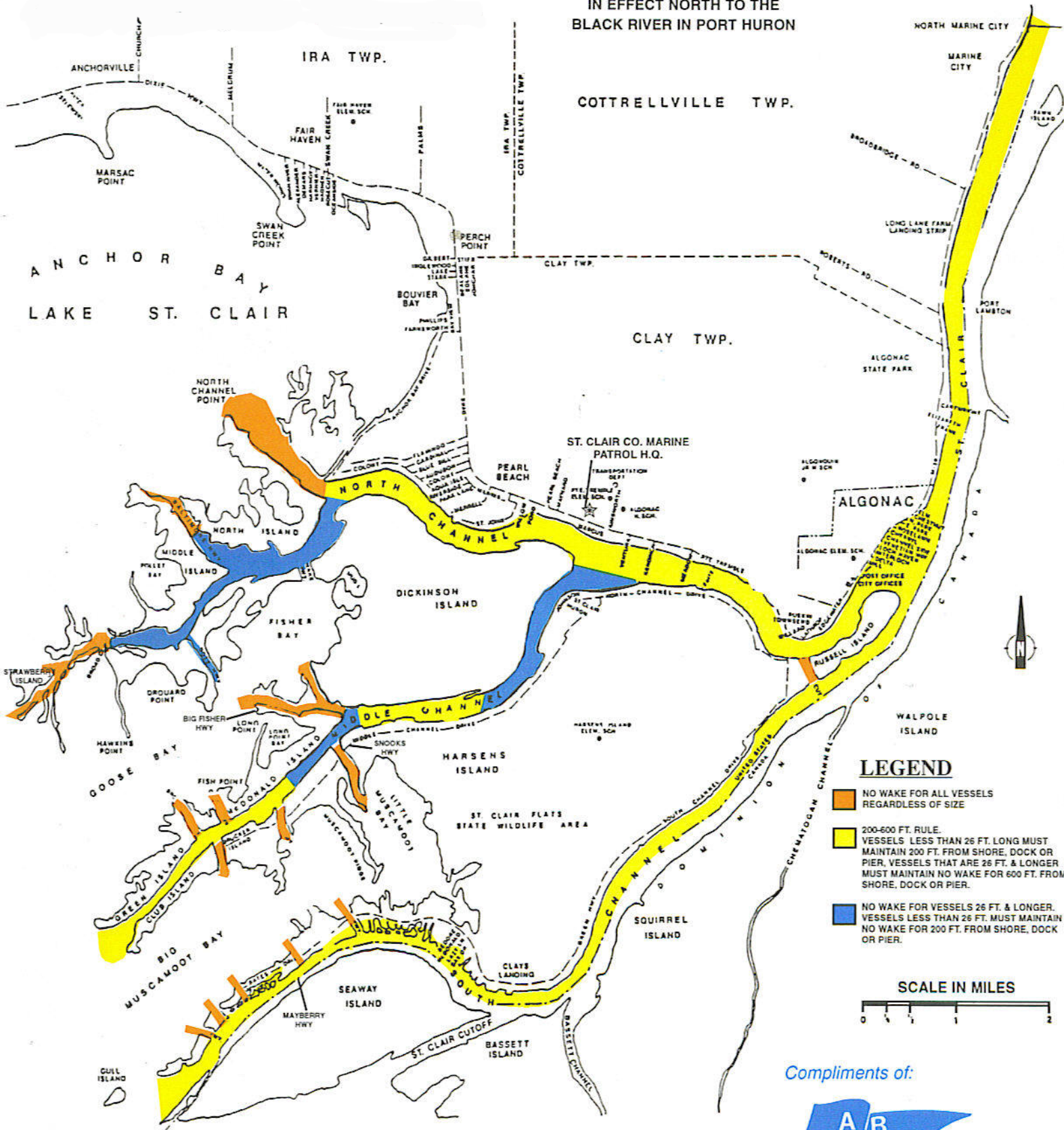


200/600 FOOT RULE IS

- NO WAKE FOR ALL VESSELS REGARDLESS OF SIZE
 - 200-600 FT. RULE. VESSELS LESS THAN 26 FT. LONG MUST MAINTAIN 200 FT. FROM SHORE, DOCK OR PIER. VESSELS THAT ARE 26 FT. & LONGER MUST MAINTAIN 600 FT. FROM SHORE, DOCK OR PIER.
 - NO WAKE FOR VESSELS 26 FT. & LONGER. VESSELS LESS THAN 26 FT. MUST MAINTAIN 200 FT. FROM SHORE, DOCK OR PIER.



THE COLOR CODED CHART SERVES AS A GENERAL GUIDE ONLY, BASED ON THE WIDTHS OF VARIOUS CHANNELS, CANALS AND RIVERS. THE LAW FOR THE ST. CLAIR RIVER AND CHANNELS IS THE SAME THROUGHOUT THE RIVER SYSTEM.
